2. The name of the subject of the contract

„Radiochemical (radiological) analyses of surface waters and groundwater“

3. Description of the subject of the contract and its scope

The subject of the contract are radiochemical (radiological) analyses of surface waters and groundwater.

The subject of the contract is divided into parts.

- part 1. „Radiochemical (radiological) determination of beta and alpha total volume activity in surface waters and groundwater“
- part 2: „Radiochemical (radiological) determination of tritium in surface waters and groundwater“

The tenderer may submit a tender for the whole subject of the contract or only for one of the parts of the contract.

Part 1. of the subject of the contract „Radiochemical (radiological) determination of beta and alpha total volume activity in surface waters and groundwater“

The subject of part 1 of the contract is radiochemical (radiological) determination of the total volume activity of beta and alpha in surface waters and groundwater in the supplied samples of surface waters and groundwater in order to obtain representative values of the required indicator. A limit of determination of 0.1 Bq / l is required for a total beta volume activity and for a total alpha volume activity of not more than 0.04 Bq / l. Accreditation of the method used is also required.

The subject of the contract is procured for the needs of:

- geological task „*Geological survey of the environment of a landfill on the site of Hlohovec – Vlčie Hory*“, task No. 08 19, financed by the state budget;
- project „*Hydrogeological survey of the deficit territories of the Slovak Republic*“, ITMS code 310031N706, geological task 05 18, financed by the European Regional Development Fund, Operational Programme Quality of Environment.

Total number of samples analysed for the duration of the Framework Agreement: 76 sample analyses.

Of these:

- for the needs of the geological task „*Geological survey of the environment of a landfill on the site of Hlohovec – Vlčie Hory*“: **28 sample analyses.**
- for the needs of the project „*Hydrogeological survey of the deficit territories of the Slovak Republic*“: **48 sample analyses.**

Analyses of samples will be performed on an ongoing basis within the duration of the Framework Agreement by 31.12.2020 on the basis of the Call for Partial Performance delivered to the successful tenderer. The output of the performed analyses will be protocols on the analysis of water samples.

The maximal expected number of sampling campaigns is for:

- for the needs of the geological task „*Geological survey of the environment of a landfill on the site of Hlohovec – Vlčie Hory*“: 1 sampling campaign, i.e. single turnout.
- for the needs of the project „*Hydrogeological survey of the deficit territories of the Slovak Republic*“: 4 sampling campaigns.

The subject of the contract also includes the supply of sample boxes for sampling to the address of the contracting authority and the collection of sample boxes with samples for the implementation of sample analyses from the address of the contracting authority pursuant to points 7 and 8 of this Call.

Part 2: „Radiochemical (radiological) determination of tritium in surface waters and groundwater“

The subject of part 2 of the contract is Radiochemical (radiological) determination of tritium in surface waters and groundwater in the supplied samples of surface waters and groundwater in order to obtain representative values of the required indicator. Not greater than 0.24 Bq / l MDA for tritium volume activity after electrolytic concentration is required.

Total number of samples analysed for the duration of the Framework Agreement: 248.

Analyses of samples will be performed on an ongoing basis (in the maximal expected number of 12 sampling campaigns, 20 to 25 samples pre one sampling campaign) within the duration of the Framework Agreement by 31.12.2020 on the basis of the Call for Partial Performance delivered to the successful tenderer. The output of the performed analyses will be protocols on the analysis of water samples.

The subject of the contract involves also the supply of sample boxes for sampling in the maximum expected number of 12 deliveries to the address of the public contracting authority (Štátny geologický ústav Dionýza Štúra, Mlynská dolina 1, 817 04 Bratislava) and taking back of sample boxes with samples for sample analysis in the maximum estimated number of 12 deliveries from the following address of the contracting authority (Štátny geologický ústav Dionýza Štúra, Regionálne centrum Spišská Nová Ves, Markušovská cesta 1, 052 40 Spišská Nová Ves) pursuant to points 7 and 8 of this Call.

In the case the tenderer is submitting his offer by surface mail or by similar way of delivery, it is required to be placed within a fixed envelope marked by sign: “Tender – Radiochemical (radiological) analyses of surface waters and groundwater, DO NOT OPEN / NEOTVÁRAŤ“ within the deadline for price offer submission.

Price offer delivered after the deadline will not be accepted. In the case when tenderer is submitting his offer by surface mail or by similar way of delivery, the crucial point for decision is the time of its delivery to the aforementioned address. If the price offers are delivered in person, these should be submitted in working days between 9:00 and 15:00, while during the last day of offer submission the tenderers should respect the announced time of the deadline.

11. The main financing conditions

The condition of participation in public procurement according to the § 32, par. 1, letter f) of the Public Procurement Act concerning personal status - the contracting authority requires the submission of a affidavit signed by a person authorized to act on behalf of the tenderer that he does not have a ban on participation in public procurement confirmed by a final decision in the Slovak Republic or state of residence, place of business or usual residence. If the law of the state of the applicant with its registered office, place of business or usual residence outside the territory of the Slovak Republic does not regulate the institute of affidavit, it may be replaced by a statement made in court, administrative body, notary, or other professional institution or business institution according to regulations in the state of residence, place of business or habitual residence of the tenderer. A pattern of the affidavit is in the Annex No. 3 of this Call.

Submission of the affidavit is not required in the case of a tenderer listed in the list of economic entities maintained by the Public Procurement Office in the Slovak Republic.

The tenderer shall submit a photocopy of the said document.

Conditions for participation in public procurement pursuant to the § 34 of the Public Procurement Act concerning technical or professional competence: § 34 par. 1, letter c) of the Public Procurement Act - the contracting authority requires the successful tenderer the submission of a certificate of accreditation of the analytical method used for determination issued by an authorized accreditation body by the successful tenderer.

The successful tenderer shall submit a photocopy of the said document and its official translation into the state language (Slovak language). This does not apply to the documents prepared in the Czech language.

13. Elaboration of a price offer, currency and prices stated in the offer, currency of the financial performance

The tenderer may submit a tender for the whole subject of the contract or only for one of the parts of the contract. If tenders are submitted for both parts of the contract, tenders should be submitted separately for each of the parts of the contract.

The tender price proposed by the tenderer for the delivery of the required subject of the contract, its parts stated in the tenderer's offer, should be expressed in EUROS, rounded to two decimal places.

Offer for the part 1. of the subject of the contract „Radiochemical (radiological) determination of beta and alpha total volume activity in surface waters and groundwater“ submitted by the tenderer must contain:

- proposal for performance stating the detection limit of alpha and beta volume activity determination;
- unit price for sample analysis in EUROS excluding VAT;
- the total price for the analysis of samples for the geological task No. 08 19 „*Geological survey of the environment of a landfill on the site of Hlohovec – Vlčie Hory*“ (28 sample analyses) in EUROS excluding VAT, amount of VAT and the total price in EUROS including VAT;
- the total price for the analysis of samples for the project „*Hydrogeological survey of the deficit territories of the Slovak Republic*“ (48 sample analyses) in EUROS excluding VAT, amount of VAT and the total price in EUROS including VAT;
- the total price for the subject of the contract in EUROS excluding VAT, amount of VAT and the total price in EUROS including VAT;
- indication of the names and number/code of the project/geological task in relation to the prices quoted.

The price offer will also include the price for the delivery and collection of sampling bottles / sampling boxes and the delivery of the results of analyses / protocol originals to the address of the contracting authority.

It must be clear from the submitted price offer that the total price of the part 1 of the subject of the contract includes the complete provision of the service specified in the point 3 of this Invitation for part 1 of the subject of the contract.

Offer for the part 2. of the subject of the contract: „Radiochemical (radiological) determination of tritium in surface waters and groundwater“ submitted by the tenderer must contain:

- proposal for performance stating the detection limit of tritium volume activity determination;
- unit price for sample analysis in EUROS excluding VAT;
- the total price for the analysis of 248 samples 248 in EUROS excluding VAT, amount of VAT and the total price in EUROS including VAT;
- indication of the name and project code - „*Hydrogeological survey of the deficit territories of the Slovak Republic*“, ITMS kód 310031N706;
- the price offer will also include the price for the delivery and collection of sampling bottles / sampling boxes and the delivery of the results of analyses / protocol originals to the address of the contracting authority.

It must be clear from the submitted price offer that the total price of the part 2 of the subject of the contract includes the complete provision of the service specified in the point 3 of this Invitation for part 2 of the subject of the contract.

The price offer prepared in accordance with this Invitation must be signed by the statutory representative of the tenderer or a person authorized to act on behalf of the tenderer and the imprint of the tenderer's stamp.

The tenderer determines the price for the procured object of the contract on the basis of his own calculations, activities, expenses and income according to the valid legal regulations.

Before submitting his offer, the tenderer is obliged to take into account everything necessary for the full and proper performance of the subject of the contract, **including all costs associated with the performance of the subject of the contract** (provision of the service in question) **in his prices**, i.e. all expenses that the supplier necessarily or expediently incurs in the implementation of the subject of the contract (delivery / collection of sampling bottles / sampling boxes and delivery of analysis results / protocol originals to the contracting authority, other related costs).

The accepted agreed prices stated in the price offer will be unchanged and binding for the conclusion of the Framework Agreement for the delivery of the subject of the contract - its part.

If the tenderer is a taxable person for VAT in accordance with the relevant regulations (hereinafter referred to as the "taxable person"), he shall state the proposed contract price in the following composition:

- proposed contract price in EUROS excluding value added tax (further on „VAT“),
- VAT amount in EUROS,
- proposed contract price in EUROS including VAT.

If the tenderer is not a taxable person for VAT, he shall state the proposed price in EUROS in total including VAT. The fact that he is not a taxable person for VAT will be stated by the tenderer in the offer ("I am not a VAT payer" should be stated).

For non-payers, the total prices will be evaluated and for VAT payers the total prices including VAT will be evaluated.

If the tenderer is not a registered VAT payer in the Slovak Republic and the tax liability is transferred, he shall state the proposed contract price without VAT. He will point out this fact in the price offer. To the thus proposed contract price excluding VAT, the tenderer shall add the amount of VAT which the contracting authority would be obliged to pay within the applicable legislation. The price to be evaluated will be determined by the sum of the proposed contract price and all taxes and payments that the contracting authority would be obliged to pay by accepting this offer.

14. Criteria for the evaluation of tenders and the method of their evaluation

For the part 1. of the subject of the contract „Radiochemical (radiological) determination of beta and alpha total volume activity in surface waters and groundwater“

The criterion for the evaluation of offers is the lowest price in total for the part 1 of the subject of the contract stated in the point 3 of this Call in EUROS including VAT.

Weighting: 100 points (maximal score)

The maximum number of points will be awarded to the offer with the lowest total price for the part 1 of the subject of the contract including VAT and for other tenders will be determined by proportion. The evaluation of this criterion for other offers shall be expressed as the ratio of the lowest total price for the part 1 of the subject of the contract including VAT and the proposed total price for the part 1 of the subject of the contract including VAT of the relevant evaluated offer, multiplied by the maximum number of points for the criterion – i.e. 100 points.

$$\text{„Criterion“} = \frac{\text{the lowest total price for the delivery of part 1 of the subject of the contract including VAT}}{\text{the total price for the delivery of the part 1 of the subject of the contract of the relevant evaluated offer including VAT}} \times 100$$

When evaluating the criterion, the lowest total price in EUROS including VAT will be evaluated the highest and the highest total price in EUROS including VAT will be evaluated the lowest (when calculating the allocated points for price offers, conversion over the ratio of the lowest price offer to the relevant evaluated price offer will be used, i.e. proportional method).

The order of the other candidates will be determined according to the number of points obtained in ascending order.

The successful tenderer will be the tenderer whose offer reaches the highest score after mutual comparison of the total number of points.

All calculations are rounded into two decimal places according to mathematical rules.

For the part 2. of the subject of the contract: „Radiochemical (radiological) determination of tritium in surface waters and groundwater”

The criterion for the evaluation of offers is the lowest price in total for the part 2 of the subject of the contract stated in the point 3 of this Call in EUROS including VAT.

Weighting: 100 points (maximal score)

The maximum number of points will be awarded to the offer with the lowest total price for the part 2 of the subject of the contract including VAT and for other tenders will be determined by proportion. The evaluation of this criterion for other offers shall be expressed as the ratio of the lowest total price for the part 2 of the subject of the contract including VAT and the proposed total price for the part 2 of the subject of the contract including VAT of the relevant evaluated offer, multiplied by the maximum number of points for the criterion – i.e. 100 points.

When evaluating the criterion, the lowest total price in EUROS including VAT will be evaluated the highest and the highest total price in EUROS including VAT will be evaluated the lowest (when calculating the allocated points for price offers, conversion over the ratio of the lowest price offer to the relevant evaluated price offer will be used, i.e. proportional method).

The order of the other candidates will be determined according to the number of points obtained in ascending order.

The successful tenderer will be the tenderer whose offer reaches the highest score after mutual comparison of the total number of points.

All calculations are rounded into two decimal places according to mathematical rules.

15. Reasons for cancellation of the tender

The contracting authority may cancel the applied procurement procedure for the following reasons:

- no offer will be submitted,
- none of the submitted offers will meet the specified requirements,
- if the circumstances under which this contract was awarded have changed (no funds have been allocated to the contracting authority),
- its cancellation shall be ordered by the Office,

- the public procurement process will not be approved by the Intermediate Body of the Non-Refundable Financial Contribution Provider,
- no consent to the signing of the Framework Agreement will be given by the founder of the public contracting authority - the Ministry of the Environment of the Slovak Republic,
- the contracting authority reserves the right not to accept any tender if the offer price of the tenderers is higher than the anticipated financial limit of the contracting authority for the procurement of the subject of the contract – its part, specified in the point 9 of this Invitation.

16. Further information of the contracting authority


16.1 Tenders, proposals and other documents and documents in public procurement shall be submitted in the state language (Slovak language). If the document is drawn up in a foreign language, it shall be submitted together with its official translation into the state language; this does not apply to tenders, proposals and documents prepared in the Czech language. If a difference in their content is found, an official translation into the state language is decisive.

16.2 After evaluating the submitted offers, the contracting authority shall send a notice to all tenderers of the result of the evaluation of offers.

16.3 The contracting authority will conclude a Framework Agreement with the successful tenderer for the given part of the contract after the verification and approval of the public procurement process by the Slovak Environmental Agency as the Non-Refundable Financial Contribution Provider's Intermediate Body (in accordance with the valid Non-Refundable Financial Contribution Provider Manual) and after the approval by the founder of the contracting authority – the Ministry of the Environment of the Slovak Republic.
